Monochromatic colour refers to a colour scheme that is comprised of variations of one colour. Of course that does include black and white but any colour can create a monochromatic colour scheme.

For example, adding white to red creates pink, adding black to red creates maroon, etc. Then, you could have a monochromatic colour scheme of pink, red, and maroon.
