2021 ends with a shower of Gold

Not a single participating member misses out

While another dark Covid cloud is hanging over our country, and most of the rest of the world, for our club the year is ending with a shower of Gold.

Of the 38 images entered for evaluation at our last monthly meeting of the year, no fewer than 21 were awarded Gold. And another 9 received the even higher Merit award.

In fact, every single one of the 11 club members who had entered images, received at least one Gold award. Two entrants received a combination of 4 Merits and Golds each - Gary Scholtz and new member Peter Jaquire.

One of Gary's images was chosen as Image of the Month by a senior member (with a rating of 4 Star or higher), and one of Peter's by a junior member (3 Star or lower).

The evaluation results, together with a motivation for each image, were announced at our virtual meeting on Wednesday 1 December.

Standing our ground among the clubs

After the shower of Gold at our December meeting, how does our standard of photography compare with that of other clubs in our pier group?

One possible measure of that is the results of the monthly national club competitions organized by the PSSA (Photographic Society of South Africa).

The latest results – and the last to be announced in 2021 – are those for November, which is the fifth of twelve months of the competition.

The December results will be announced early next year.

So, the November results indicate that we are still hanging in there.

In the senior competition, for club members rated 4 Star and higher, we are in 4th place out of 10 in the Western

Cape region, and 14th out of about 50 clubs from all over the country participating regularly.

The top scores are still grouped together closely. Only 5 points separate us from the regional leader, Tygerberg.

In the junior competition, for members up to 3 Star, we are sticking to 6th place out of 10 regionally, and 23rd out of about 50 nationally. In this case we are 22 points behind the regional leader, Fish Hoek. They are doing exceptionally well, being 2nd nationally.

In fact, the Western Cape has two more

spread over the photographic year from July to June. There are about 25 of them open to digital photographers of all ages and star ratings.

The results of the first nine salons have been processed by the PSSA. They show that four of our club members are among the top 11 participants from Western Cape clubs. These eleven are also among the overall top 100, in other words, in the top 17% of all participants.

Of the other Western Cape clubs represented in the top 11, besides our four members, Tygerberg has three, and Cape Town, Fish Hoek, Tafelberg and Witzenberg one each.
