Our Gold Master gets 30/30

Two accolades on one day for Phil Sturgess



"Sossusvlei shoreline" by Phil Sturgess, which was given a score of 30/30 at our club's August meeting.

It took Phil Sturgess only about nine months to advance from the Master Bronze level to Master Silver – and then just eleven months more to become our club's first Master Gold photographer.

His latest Gold status was announced at our August monthly meeting on Wednesday the 2nd. To crown this achievement, one of his images was given a perfect score of 30/30 later that same evening.

The image, "Sossusvlei shoreline", had been entered for our regular monthly evaluation. That was done by guest judges Nicol and Trudi du Toit, both members of Cape Town club and PSSA (Photographic Society of South Africa) management.

Based on its top score, it was chosen as our club's image of the month and our entry in the senior monthly club competition organized by the PSSA. Our entry in the junior competition is "Blue hour mosque" by Ingrid Grundlingh.

Phil is one of a dozen Master photographers in our club. The PSSA had recognized only one Master level until 2000, but then

split it into five levels – Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum and Diamond.

To advance through the senior levels, from 4-Star to 5-Star, and then to each of the successive Master levels, a club member needs 145 points and 40 Gold or Merit awards. A full explanation of the advancement system can be found under Rules and Regulations on our club website.
